<ul> <li>I. Humility and Hospitality (Love)</li> <li>[7] Moses went out to meet his father-in-law and bowed down and kissed him. And they asked each other of their welfare and went into the tent.</li> <li>Ordinarily a great man would wait in his tent to receive a guest—and Moses had become a great</li> </ul>
man!
Yet he himself by going out to meet his father-in-law and bowed down in
respect to him
Then he gave his father-in-law a warm, affectionate embrace.
Moses invited him into the tent (middle-eastern hospitality)

II. Hearing the Good News of Salvation (Truth)  [8] Then Moses told his father-in-law all that the LORD had done to Pharaoh and to the Egyptians for Israel's sake, all the hardship that had come upon them in the way, and how the LORD had delivered them.  Moses' shared the good news of God's!  The most important thing about what Moses said is how thoroughly God-centered it was!!  Nothing he said was very about himself or the people.  The exodus was all about what had done!
